

OIS FSL / Kielitaitotasot - Language Skill Levels

C1-level (at the end of gr 9) Phase 5-6

- You normally study Finnish in FMT-lessons (Finnish as a mother tongue) but you are assessed as a FSL student.
- You can comprehend and produce complex and formal texts in different contexts
- You can recognize different styles and registers
- You are an independent Finnish user

B2-level (at the end of gr 6) Phase 3-4

- You have studied Finnish for several years.
- You can already study about abstract topics.
- You can understand themes related to general knowledge, you can participate in everyday life situations.

B1-level (at the end of gr 4) Phase 2

- After 1-2 years of studying Finnish.
- You can already communicate in simple Finnish both in speaking and writing.
- You can already study a variety of everyday themes, and basic grammar and structures.

A2-level (at the end of gr 2) – Phase 1

- When you first arrive to Finland and you start learning a new language.
- You start learning everyday vocabulary and themes, and simple grammar and structures.
