For modules with a corresponding basic mathematics module, accepted grades (5-10) as well as the grade 4 will transfer as they are to basic mathematics grades. Note that basic mathematics modules MAB4 and MAB6 are not replaced by any advanced mathematics module.

For those modules without a corresponding module, an accepted advanced mathematics grade will be transferred to basic mathematics as a grade or the pass mark S (for module MAB15). From these modules, grade 4 will not be transferred to basic mathematics unless it is supplemented to an accepted course (S).

Note that in basic mathematics, there can be at most two failing grades.

Raising grades: The student can raise a grade transferring from advanced mathematics with only an exam. The student arranges the exam date with the teacher when filling this form.

Transferring from basic to advanced mathematics: The corresponding basic mathematics course is supplemented and transferred to advanced mathematics.
