I consent to the documents pertaining to this objection being made available to the social services ombudsperson.

A parent or other guardian of a child who is dissatisfied with the quality of the early childhood education and care provided or the treatment received in that context has the right to file an objection with the daycare centre manager responsible for operations, the responsible officer of the care location, or the supervising officeholder of the early childhood and care department. The objection may be filed either using this form or by a free-form letter, which however must indicate it is an objection. For a particular reason, the objection may also be filed verbally, in which case the receiving officer will file the objection. The objection is directed at the municipality whose operations the matter concerns. If necessary, the social services ombudsperson can provide guidance and assistance with the objection.

The objection will be replied to in writing. The objection or any associated documents will not be connected the child's early childhood education and care records. A reply to an objection is not subject to an appeal. Filing an objection will not impact the right of the parent or other guardian to file complaints with the supervising authorities in their matter, nor will it impend their ability to seek appeal as separately regulated.
