Pölönen introduces his personal 5 do's and 5 don'ts. Which of these do you think are most challenging for your students? You can choose multiple options.

Do's

- know your values.
- find what you love and 'let it kill you'.
- focus on what deserves your attention.
- if opportunity doesn't knock, build a door.
- Make emotions work for you instead of against you.

Don't's

- don't waste a good crisis.
- don't look for inspiration, look for irritation.
- don't let schooling get in the way of education.
- don't let money get in the way of what's important.
- don't cling to a mistake just because you used a lot of time making it.
