## Tasks related to the main character

1. Present the main character (the character that you get to know the best in the book). Draw a picture of him/her/it. Around the main character, write words describing who he/seh/it is.
2. Describe what kind of main character the book has, what he/she/it looks like and what he/ she/it likes.
3. Using your own imagination, come up with a friend for the main character and write about him/her/it.
4. Using your own imagination, write the main character's horoscope for the week.
5. Write a letter or an email to the main character.
6. Imagine what the main character normally eats for breakfast based on what you read.

Draw and describe it.
7. Write an ACROSTIC poem (name-poem) that descibes the main character. For example:

## Tasks related to other characters

8. Draw and color a character or animal described in the book.
9. What is your favorite character from the book? Draw a picture or write about him/ her/it.
10. Make a list of characters and describe their roles in the story (e.g. Emilia - main character, Halonen - petit lizard, Simo - Emilia's best friend, etc.)
11. If you could be one of the characters, who would it be and why?
12. Name hunt: Look for and write down names of characters from the book.
13. You can see into the future. Your task is to predict what kind of life your book's character will lead at the end of the book. Write a small story.

## Tasks related to the setting of the story

14. Draw or write to show what kind of home the main character lives in.
15. Draw and colour the setting of the story.
16. Draw a map of the setting of the story.
17. Draw a time machine which will take you to the time when the story was set.
18. Place hunt. Search for and write the names of places mentioned in the book.
19. Describe with words the main setting of the book. What is it like there? What sounds can be heard? What smells are there?

## Tasks related to the events and plot of the book

20. Briefly write the plot of the book.
21. Draw and colour a picture which tells about part of the plot.
22. Choose what you think is the best part of the book and retell it to others.
23. Search for a nice part of the book and retell it to others.
24. Draw a short cartoon strip of the plot.
25. Which parts of the story could be true and which could only be imaginary?
26. Retell the plot to your parents.
27. Write a piece of news about the most important part of the book.
28. Search for a part of the book which is really exciting. Read it to your teacher or class.
29. Use your imagination and think what happens at the end of the story. Write a small story.

54. What new things have you learnt from the book?
55. Present to your class something which you have learnt from your book.

## Tasks related to poems

56. Choose a poem and illustrate it.
57. Choose a poem and edit it. Write the words of the poem in a different order.

59. Write a poem about something which has happened it the book.
