

A panel of children participated in the finishing stages by giving feedback. The panel consisted of pupils in 3rd to 6th grades.







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Take action

If you or someone else is pestered, bullied, lured or harassed, for instance, by messages and/or photos

TELL an adult you trust SAVE the messages and photos/videos by taking screenshots STOP the perpetrator from contacting you by banning him or her in your phone / social media privacy settings INFORM the website or apps administrator CONTACT the police GET SUPPORT, for instance from Victim Support Finland (RIKU), tel.116 006; riku.fi/nuoret (chat) Helpline for Children and Adolescents, tel. 116 111 Pupil Welfare Services at school

Who can you report to?

If it is not an emergency, report suspicious material or phenomena to **poliisi.fi/nettivinkki** You can also contact virtual police officers online: **poliisi.fi/some**

In case of an emergency, call **EMERGENCY NUMBER 112**

If you suspect an offence was committed against you or someone in your family **REPORT THE OFFENCE ONLINE www.poliisi.fi/rikokset/sahkoinen_rikosilmoitus or the closest police station** (in an emergency)

Report any illegal activity in relation to child sexual exploitation and child sexual abuse (for instance explicit photos and videos with minor children and young people) to **pelastakaalapset.fi/nettivihje**

The cartoon was created for educational purposes to those working with pupils in 3rd to 6th grades as well as for support to parents bringing up children. A pedagogical guideline as well as an instruction compiled for support to parents may be used when talking about the cartoon.

The cartoon tells a story about luring children online to sexual activity (i.e. grooming). The cartoon gives an opportunity to talk with children about the social safety skills needed in digital media, that is, protecting privacy or sharing photos, but it also gives safety guidelines against threatening situations. The goal of the cartoon is to encourage children to trust their intuition and judgment when interacting in digital media, and also to boost adults' abilities to support their children's growth and development in such situations.

The cartoon was produced as a joint effort by the City of Oulu's Safe Oulu Project, Work from Art Project of the Culture Power Station and Oulu Zonta Clubs. Oulu Police Department, in cooperation with the CSE Team of the National Bureau of Investigation, participated in this cartoon project, too.
