

CULTURE WALK – 15 May 2025

Ammattiopisto Lappia – Tornedalsskolan – Tornio Upper Secondary School

- 170 students divided into 24 groups

INSTRUCTIONS FOR TEACHERS

- Inform your students about the event.
- Ask your students to check in advance which group they belong to.
- The idea of the event is that the groups visit certain statues. At each statue, questions and a QR code are provided.
- Students give their answers to the teacher at the statue in Finnish or Swedish.
- For a correct answer, the teacher gives a letter. At the end, the letters form a word.
- Dress according to the weather and wear comfortable shoes – the event takes place outdoors.

Media:

If you will invite media to your event, appoint a media contact person.

Gathering at 9:30 at Victoria Square

- Everyone gathers at Victoria Square.
- Students go to their groups according to the letters. Ensure they find the correct groups.
- Maps are distributed to the groups. One teacher is responsible for preparing and printing the maps with clearly marked locations.
- The map also contains a grid for 11 letters and a space for the group name. (can be modified with different number of stations)
- One teacher distributes the QR codes, questions, and answers to the teachers. Teachers go to their designated cultural walk station. When a student group arrives, they give the QR-code to the group.
- The lead teacher reviews the instructions for everyone using a megaphone.

Culture Walk begins at 9:45

- The lead teacher sends the student groups on their way.
- Teachers proceed to their assigned statues.
- Students come up with a bilingual name for their group and write it on the map.
- At each statue, the teacher asks the students to scan the QR code.
- For each correct answer, the group receives a letter.
- The letters form a word at the end.

Return to Victoria Square by 11:30

At Krannikota, two teachers grill sausages and offer juice.

A prize will be drawn among all groups that answered correctly and created the correct word from the letters.
